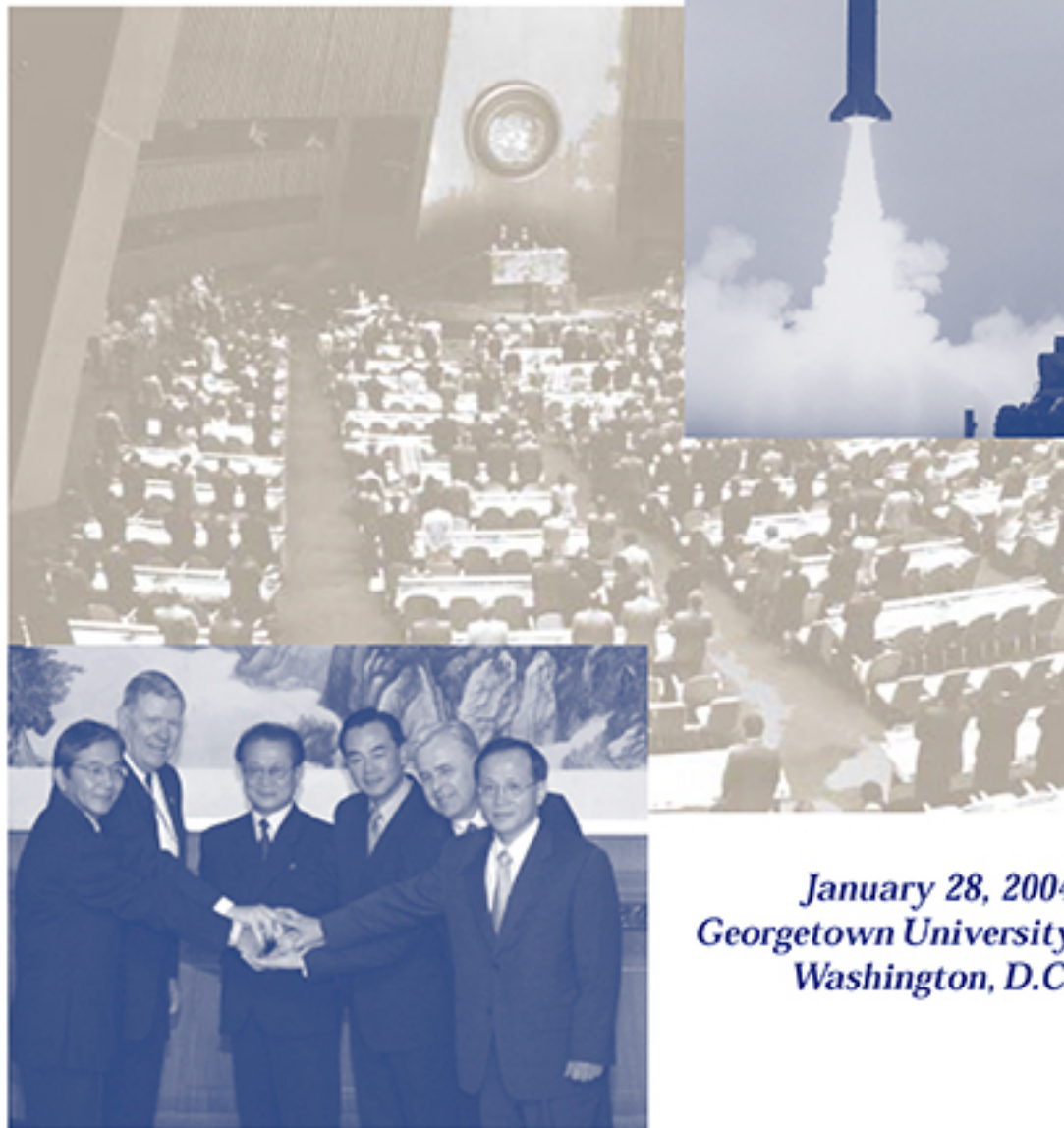


Full Proceedings of the Paul C. Warnke Conference on the Past, Present & Future of Arms Control
